

The Centre de mobilité internationale of Rennes helps you constituting your file and guides you along the process.

You are a scholarship student and you are not registered as a PhD student in a school of higher education in France. You can benefit from the Protection Universelle Maladie (PUMa).

You must be able to prove that you have a stable and regular residency in France for at least 3 months and be up to date regarding your residence permit situation so you can be taken in charge personally and continuously all along your life.

The application must be given to the Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie of Rennes. Once your application for the opening of your rights to the health insurance is registered and processed by the CPAM of Paris, you will receive an information mail stating your number of social registration number. Only once you get your social security number you can receive the refund of the health spending you might have had since the first day of your work contract.
