

The Centre de mobilité internationale of Rennes helps you constituting your file and guides you along the process.

You are a PhD student or a salaried researcher and have a visa/residence permit under the status «Passeport talent chercheur»: you must give your affiliation application (application for a social security number) to the Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie (CPAM) of Paris, which centralizes the application of people under this status.

The Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie (CPAM) is the organization in charge of insuring the health expenses up to 70% and guarantees the access to treatments.

Once your application for the opening of your rights to the health insurance is registered and processed by the CPAM of Paris, you will receive an information mail stating your social registration number. Only once you get your social security number you can receive the refund of the health spending you might have had since the first day of your work contract. Obtaining a social security number takes at least 1 month and a half.
